You might need another set of hands or a jack. don't forget the O2 sensor wiring. Take off the heat shields if they're present. Next comes the transmission. Unbolt the trans mount so that it's kinda hanging. Remove the 3 bolts for the drive shaft (there's six, but look carefully, you only need to remove 3).

In 1993, the M40 was replaced by the BMW M43 SOHC engine and the M42 was replaced in 1996 by the BMW M44 DOHC engine. For the six-cylinder models, the E36 was launched with the then-new BMW M50 DOHC petrol engine. In 1993 the M50TU versions added single-VANOS (variable valve timing), which increased torque (peak power was unchanged).

There are two ways to replace a starter on an E36, you can either remove the intake manifold to replace the starter from the top or you can access it from the bottom by removing the transmission or in the case of manual transmissions you can access it from the bottom without having to remove the transmission.

How to replace a BMW E36 starter - A Better BMW

A BMW E36 oil separator valve replacement is a very straightforward repair and can be easily performed by the home mechanic. Contrary to other repair articles, you do not need to remove the intake manifold on the BMW E36 engine to extract the oil separator valve from underneath it.

Remove the two 10mm bolts securing the left engine cover to the fuel rail. Remove the engine cover from the vehicle. Begin by unclipping the oxygen sensor wires from the top of the fuel rail as shown below. Carefully stow them safely out of the work area.

To remove the intake manifold, you need to remove the engine wire harness first and slide it out of the way. Start by unscrewing the main plugs (green arrows, lower right). Then, loosen the main wire junction box (blue arrow) by lifting up the rain tray under the wipers and removing the two small screws contained within (red arrow, upper right).

Car Model: BMW E36. The engine coolant temperature sensor is responsible for sending the temperature of the engine to the DME and the instrument cluster. It is a four wire sensor, with two separate circuits, one for the instrument cluster and one for the DME.

Remove the valve cover vent hose at the front right of the valve cover, pull over to the side. Start disconnecting the ignition coil electrical harness's- Lift the metal locking tab and pull. Remove the coil harness ground wire between coils 2-3. Now start removing the coils, two bolts per coil. There are coil ground straps at coils 1 & 6.

Steps required to replace the control arms on a BMW E36: Step 1: Jack up the car and remove the wheels. Use a floor jack to raise the nose of the car. Place jack stands under the jack points behind the front wheels and lower the vehicle onto them. Use a 17mm socket to remove the lug nuts and then pull off the wheels. Step 2: Remove the swaybar ...
