Explanation of the Five Themes of Geography

Medical Geography: This is the branch of geography that deals with the study of patterns and spread of diseases.This involves epidemics and pandemics and their origins and distribution over a given geographical location. Religious geography: This is the branch of human geography that studies the spread and distribution of religious groups, their culture and the built environment.

While paper 1 focusses mainly on theory and concepts, paper 2 is all about the interpretation of maps, diagrams, photographs and other graphical information. Some skills should be practised in advance to obtain higher marks on this paper. Calculating distances. Maps will have a scale of 1:25000 or 1:50000.
